In Fiscal Year 2017, Community Services Foundation provided CTF ILLINOIS with a grant to receive official CQL (Council on Quality and Leadership) training and accreditation. This training and accreditation process helped CTF **develop** a plan of action to ensure services emphasize the individuals we support and their unique needs, wants, and goals. By providing the funding for this accreditation process, CSF helped CTF **develop** into a premier human services organization with a clearer focus on person-centered supports.

Through serving the south suburbs of Chicago for years, ACCESS Behavioral Health discovered an unmet need within their community: there is a lack of facilities with expanded hours for mental health supports. In order to **create** an opportunity to meet this need, CSF purchased a building in South Holland where CTF provides services from. Now, CSF has helped **create** a new option for the community to utilize after typical business hours, including a 24/7 crisis hotline.


that will **support**...

and **inspire independence**.


